# TEMPORARY COVID-19 RULES FOR COURTROOM

#### ENTRY TO COURTOOM:

Effective immediately, other than court personnel, only parties, their counsel, custodial parents of juveniles who are charged in delinquency or unruly cases, and witnesses who are testifying, shall be permitted in the courtroom. No spouses, boyfriends, girlfriends, family members, witnesses who are not testifying, or any other person shall be admitted to the courtroom without prior court approval.

#### **VACCINATED:**

While not required, it is recommended that fully vaccinated individuals wear a mask when entering the courtroom.

## **UNVACCINATED:**

Unvaccinated individuals are required to wear a mask at all times in the courtroom. Masks may be removed when testifying, if desired.

#### **NOTICE**

The Court reserves the right to require any individual not wearing a mask to provide proof of vaccination by producing a valid vaccination card that indicates the date(s) on which the individual was vaccinated.
